
CatsNAP Anesthesia and Surgical Release Form

Feline Neuter (orchiectomy) is the **surgical removal of the testicles** – the scrotum will remain. Neutering makes cats sterile so they are unable to reproduce–they can still get female cats pregnant for up to 4 weeks after surgery. The typical male urine odor will also bereduced that can take several weeks. Some male cats will still spray urine after being neutered and may still want to go outside to hunt.

General anesthesia is required to perform the surgery. We will take many precautions before, during and after the surgery to avoid complications. However, **complications as a direct result of anesthetic drugs and/or surgery, up to and including death, are possible** – these complications are very rare.

CatsNAP (Cats Neutered at Parkdale) is a reduced fee cat neuter service offered by and at Parkdale Veterinary Wellness Center only. Intact male cats that are in **good physical condition**, have two **descended testicles and are at least 4 months of age** will be neutered. **Cost of an exam, the neuter and a rabiesvaccine is \$30**. Recommended lab tests, medication, vaccines and other preventive/surgical care are not included in this price.

If my cat has fleas he will be treated at an additional cost which will be paid before discharge from the hospital.

CatsNAP does not encourage you to approach stray or wild cats. They can be dangerous and transmit serious diseases, including deadly rabies. Their bites and scratches can lead to severe infection sometimes requiring surgery.
